Available Servant Isaiah 6.1-8

1. How is your self-awareness? If you are comfortable sharing, what is your most embarrassing "lack of self-awareness" moment?
2. King Uzziah was an important figure in Isaiah's life and the nation. Why does God choose this time of distress to reveal himself to Isaiah?
3. What is the most vivid encounter with the holiness of God you have ever experienced? Was it anything like Isaiah's? Give this one a lot of thought.
4. John 12.40-41 relates this vision to Jesus. How is Jesus' glory like the suffering and healing Isaiah saw?
5. What makes Isaiah despair for his life and confess his sin (see Ex 20.19; 33.20)? Have you ever had this experience? What was it like?
6. What is the significance of Isaiah's lips being touched with a coal from the altar?
7. What does it mean to make yourself available to God? Why is this important to do this before you attempt to meet the needs of others? What can happen if you don't?
8. What keeps people from saying "Here I am" to God? Where are you saying "Not me" when you should be saying "Here I am"?
9. Where do you most see a need right now - at work, home, neighborhood? How is God inviting you to step into it?
