






Mary's Monthly Meal Recipe

Sour Cream Beef Noodle Casserole

12 oz uncooked wide egg noodles
1-1 1/2 pounds ground beef
1 onion, finely diced
2 med garlic cloves
15 oz tomato sauce
15 oz diced tomatoes, drained
1 T Worchestershire sauce
2 t smoked paprika
red pepper flakes, to taste
salt and pepper, to taste
salt and pepper, to taste
8 oz sour cream
8 oz small curd cottage cheese
1/2 cup parmesan cheese
2 cups cheddar cheese
fresh parsley to garnish, optional



Cook egg noodles to el dente, rinse with cold water

Brown ground beef and drain Add chopped onion and garlic to beef and simmer about 3 minutes

Add to beef mixture and simmer for about 5 minutes until it thickens: tomato sauce, diced tomatoes, Worch sauce, paprika, red pepper flakes, salt and pepper.

In a large bowl combine: sour cream, cottage cheese, parmesan cheese, and the egg noodles.

Spoon 1/2 of cream/noodle mix in 9 x 13
Top with 1/2 of beef mixture and 1/2 of cheddar cheese

Repeat

Bake uncovered at 350 degrees for 25-30 minutes. Top with optional parsley

Celebrating Our Team



After coming to Love INC to seek help with tangible goods, Eloise Gardner joined and eventually graduated from our LIFE Skills program. She began volunteering at LIFE Skills immediately after graduating to give back to what was done for her and her family. She was hired shortly thereafter as a caseworker and program leader, and she now also serves as the DHHS navigator. Here's what she shared of her time at Love INC so far:

I love working at Love INC, because my responsibilities here line up with my spiritual gifts. I love working in the trenches alongside people who desperately need to see the grace of God and his faithfulness in their lives and helping participants find their true identity in Christ.

I will never forget when one of my participants, who wasn't previously interested in becoming a Christian, gave her life to God. Though prayer and quiet moments, she realized God was calling out to her, and her life was forever transformed.

Pantry Spotlight

Our mission here at Love INC is to mobilize local churches to transform lives and communities in the Name of Christ. That's why our church partnerships are so important to us. We envision a world where Christian churches are united in purpose and fully engaged in actively living out their faith by lovingly serving people in need in their communities.

To keep in accordance with our mission, as of March 1, we will be closing our Appliance and Furniture Pantries. These pantries have not operated within our mission for some time, and our current situation is not sustainable. We have sought for volunteers from local churches to take these pantries on, but without success. We apologize for the inconvenience this will cause. However, while these pantries fill a gap in our community*, without a church (or group of volunteers) taking full ownership of them, we are not mobilizing local churches—we're not giving congregations the opportunity to actively live out their faith. We'd love to see a church take these over, and avoid closure.

We continuously evaluate what is best for each of our pantries, and we hope to one day have these gaps filled again. But until then, we feel we must not lose sight of our mission.

Would you join us in prayer for these pantries in these next couple of months of transition?

*On average, in 2023, the Appliance pantry was used 3.5 times per month and the Furniture Pantry was used 9.5 times per month.

Growing hope out of homelessness through relationships

We've much to be thankful for this holiday season at Love INC Allegan County. In March, we put our 10 Homes for 10 Families campaign in front of you for the first time. We told you we wanted to provide 10 mobile homes over 5 years to families who complete the transitional housing portion of our Homes of Hope Program and that, to do so, we would need to raise \$300,000. We knew this was no small feat. We knew it would take the help of fellow Christ-followers (our local churches), generous donors, and eager families who are ready to reach their God-given potential. But we also knew the importance of enabling home ownership and independence from state subsidies in a community with a lack of safe, affordable housing.

What we couldn't predict in March, is the outpouring of support from generous donors, excited community members, and partner organizations.

As of today, we are the owners of two mobile homes, one of which was gifted to us by Family Promise of West Michigan and the other, of which, is already in the process of being remodeled. And through the generous support of donors like you, we've raised \$110,420 of the necessary \$300,000 to bring this program to life.

We cannot thank you enough!

You've warmed our hearts with your support, and this November, we'd like to present you with an opportunity to warm the homes of the 10 families whose lives will be forever transformed through this program.



In this initial phase of purchasing, placing and refurbishing homes for the program, we've presented you with tangible opportunities to make a difference each month. We've asked you to collectively help provide the funding for roofs, siding, electrical and plumbing updates, sub-flooring, and more.

But this month, it only takes 10 generous people to provide the next step. Could you be one of them? Could you give \$1,600 to purchase one of 10 new furnaces, providing heat for one of 10 families?

GROWING HOPE Mallory's Story

"He sent forth his Word and healed them; He rescued them from the grave."

- Psalm 107:20

Suffering from the after-effects of brainwashing and abuse from my kids' dad, I moved back home with my mom and stepdad at the age of 30 and, soon after, joined the LIFE Skills program with Love INC. It was here that I found resources I would have never found on my own and was surrounded by people who were hurting just like me.

At Love INC, my mentor went over my finances and assured me, in contrast to what I'd been told for close to 10 years, that I was actually making very wise decisions. We read a book that helped me see that I had been abused my entire life. I realized that I knew about God, but I didn't know I was keeping him at arms' length. In desperate need of peace and wanting my children to have a different life than I had growing up, I prayed that God would take over my life.

There wasn't one thing in my life that wasn't broken, and I had no idea how to fix it. I wanted God to create beauty from the ashes that I found myself in.

Love INC's 10 Homes Program is an answer to prayer. It's a bit surreal that this could be a reality for my kids and me. I still struggle to understand and except that it's possible.

But if God can make water where there is none, a way in the desert, and streams in the wasteland (Isaiah 43:18-21), then he can also create beauty from my ashes. With the 10 Homes Program, for the first time ever, my children and I could call a home our own.
