

# **SAFETY PROCEDURES FOR CHESAPEAKE KIDS**

**(as of 12-6-2020)**

Our upcoming services on December 6, which continue to be in a limited capacity, will allow for additional opening for Chesapeake Kids. We want to share the following information with you in order for you to be prepared and help with implementation of the following:

1. Chesapeake Kids will only be open for children two years old to children in the 5th grade.
2. The two-year-old, three-year-old and four-year-old classes will meet at the 11am service only. These classes will meet in rooms 114 and 111 with a capacity limit of 10 individuals. This will be on a first come/first serve basis.
3. The Kindergarten to 5th Grade Class will meet at the 11am service only. This class will continue to meet in the gymnasium with a capacity limit of 30 individuals. This will also be on a first come/first serve basis.
4. As of December 6, every elementary-aged child attending Chesapeake Kids must sit 6 feet apart.
5. Upon arriving at Chesapeake Christian Fellowship:
  - a. You will not be allowed to enter the building until 15 minutes before the start of each service.
  - b. A waiting line with the appropriate 6 foot social-distancing requirement will be established outside the front door.
6. Upon entering the building:
  - a. Bring your face mask as it is required to wear at all times for individuals over the age of four. If you wish for your two, three and/or four-year-old to wear a mask in our classes the teachers will do their best to ensure that their mask stays on.
  - b. Everyone's temperature will be taken. Those with a temperature of 100.4 or above will not be allowed entrance.
  - c. Your child will need to be escorted to the Chesapeake Kids hallway where a member of the Chesapeake Kids team will check your child in. We ask that the parent place the check-in tag on their own child.
  - d. Hand sanitizer stations will be available upon entering and exiting the classroom.
  - e. The elementary-aged children will be escorted to their seats where they will remain for the entirety of the service. We will not be playing any large group games or running around the gym.
  - f. The two, three and four-year-old classes will have toys, crayons, and craft supplies that will be sanitized after each use.
  - g. Water fountains will not be available. Your child is permitted to bring their own water bottle.

- h. Bathrooms will be available but on a limited basis (only two at a time).
- 7. At the completion of service, please line up at the gym or classroom doors (6 ft apart) to pick your child up. Parents will not be permitted to enter the gym or classrooms.
- 8. At dismissal we will ask that you remove and dispose of your child's check-in sticker once your claim tag has been checked.

**Please note: *It is your responsibility to ensure the health of your family. If someone is ill or is of compromised health, please be sure that they stay home. All of us helping one another will keep all of us safe and healthy.***
