Paul in Athens: Acts 17:16-34

- **Paul was Distressed** by the spiritual condition and the normalcy of idolatry within Athenian society.
- **Paul Reasoned with the People** regarding the truth of the Gospel.
- **Paul was Preaching Jesus and the Good News of the Resurrection.**
- **Paul Contextualized His Message.**
