Sermon Outline: Where is Your Treasure?

What topic do people hate to talk about in church? _____

What specifically impacted you from the words of Jesus in Matt 6:19-24 as they were read 3 times?

Context Notes:

Main Point - **Why does Jesus warn His followers about treasures? He knows that our stuff and money can be the most blinding and enslaving things on earth, pulling us away from what He made us for and what life should be about.**

Main Point Reprise – Don't be a fool...Money is a tool.

How do Jesus' words impact us?

1. Audit the Heart – Culture – Who is your master?
2. Consider the Cost – Lose everything.
3. Consider THE Cost – He became poor. (2 Cor 8:9)
4. Try Generosity – Authentic mark of believers

What is Jesus asking you to do as a next step?

Discussion Questions:

- On a scale of 1-10 (10 very hard), how hard is it for you to hear about money in church?
- What does Jesus mean when He told His follower to store up treasures in heaven?
- What does it look like for someone's heart to be with their earthly treasures?
- What does it look like for someone's heart to be with Treasures in Heaven?
- How do you know when your heart is treasuring the wrong things?
- In what ways was Jesus' death on the cross generous to us?
- Think of a generous person you know? How do they show generosity?
- If we are to give sacrificially - - What about saving? What about retirement? What about good stewardship?
- What is a step the Lord wants you to take toward being more generous?

Matt 6:19-24 (NIV)

Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

The eye is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are good, your whole body will be full of light. But if your eyes are bad, your whole body will be full of darkness, how great is that darkness!

No one can serve two masters. Either he will hate the one and love the other or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.
