

Trinity Small Groups Host Responsibilities

A host is much more than a place to meet! A host offers Christian hospitality and works together with the leader to make the group a place of deep relationships and growth.

Provide a Clean, Comfortable Home Environment

- House clean and picked up
- Comfortable chairs
- Enough lighting
- Free of strong pet odors
- Free from interruptions

Provide Warm and Friendly Environment

The host makes sure that people feel welcomed, makes introductions, and seeks to keep everyone integrated.

Provide Feedback for Leader

The host needs to be in regular communication with the leader to evaluate how things are going in the group: what's working, what needs improvement, how are people doing...

Provide Support for Leader

The host supports the leader especially when the rest of the group seems silent or hesitant by breaking the ice or jump-starting the conversation.

Organize Meals for Members in Hospital or meet other special needs

When people in the group are in the hospital or in special need, the group offers pastoral care. The host helps organize meals or other special needs, for example a ride to the doctor.

Organize refreshments, socials, or service projects

The host is not responsible for providing refreshments every week (unless they want to!), but for making sure that *someone* provides refreshments at every meeting. Likewise, when a social event or service project is being scheduled, the host makes sure the details come together.
