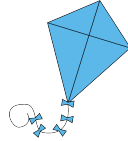

Our Key Passages This Month:

Jeremiah 29:11 (CSB)

K-5th: "I know the plans I have for you" - this is the LORD's declaration - "plans for your well-being, not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope."

Preschool: "I know the plans I have for you...plans... to give you a future and a hope."

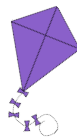
Toddlers: "I know the plans I have for you."

Beginning 3/22 | Peter 5:10 (CSB)

K-5th: "The God of all grace, who called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, establish, strengthen, and support you after you have suffered a little while."

Preschool: "God... will himself restore...you after you have suffered a little while."

Toddlers: "God...will...restore...you."



What We're Learning

After the Israelites' disobedience led to 70 years in exile in Babylon, God kept His promise to bring His people home to Judah. Prophets encouraged the people to rebuild the temple. Even after returning home, the Israelites struggled to obey God and to worship Him.

3/1 - The Captives Come Home

- Zerubbabel led God's people back to the temple to rebuild it.
- The temple was the place where God met with His people on earth.
- Jesus came to earth to rescue God's people.
- One day Jesus will return to restore a greater home for all of God's people, and we will spend eternity with Him.

3/8 - The Temple was Rebuilt

- After facing opposition and hardship, God's people finally rebuilt so they would have a place to worship God.
- Years later, God sent His Son, Jesus, to be with His people.
- Now God dwells not in the temple, but directly with His people.
- Jesus provided something better than the temple; He gives us Himself.

3/15 - Zechariah the Prophet

- Zechariah told the people that God was going to help His people and give them a different kind of king.
- Jesus is the King who came and rode humbly on a donkey, just as Zechariah said.
- Because Zechariah's prophecy came true in Jesus, we can have hope and forgiveness of sins when we trust in Jesus.

3/22 - Esther Saved Her People

- God was in control over Haman's evil plan to destroy the Jews.
- Like Haman, Satan wants to ruin God's plan and destroy believers.
- Satan thought he had won when Jesus died on the cross, but God raised Jesus from the dead and defeated Satan once and for all. All who believe in Jesus are rescued from sin and death.

3/29 - The Walls Rebuilt

- Nehemiah led the people to rebuild the walls around Jerusalem to protect them from their enemies.
- Jesus came to protect us from our greatest enemy, sin and death.
