Options and Key Dates

VOTING OPTIONS:

Vote by mail:

- 1) Request ballot online
- 2) Use application mailed to you
- 3) Return by mail or bring to City Hall (by 3:00 p.m. November 3)

Vote in person:

- 1) Early/absentee voting at City Hall
- 2) Direct balloting (October 27 – November 2; different application used)
- 3) Curbside
- 4) Election Day (curbside also available)

DATES:

From Secretary of State:

October 13 – Last day to pre-register

October 19 – Last day to change your vote

November 3 – Election Day

November 10 – Last day ballots accepted if postmarked by November 3

From USPS:

October 19 – Mail absentee ballot request form deadline

October 27 – Mail ballot deadline
