TRIP GUIDELINES

#1 – Guys & girls will be traveling in separate vans and touring the museum in separate groups.

#2 – Students will be expected to participate in group activities during the long 6 hour drive each way vs. having individual time or breaking off with a buddy.

#3 – It is not necessary to send a phone with your student. Any phones will be kept by trip chaperones. Students will only have access to use phones to call home before bed and/or in the morning before breakfast. If they want to take pictures, they will need to do so on a “camera only” device.

#5 – Dress Guidelines as Follows:

- No tank-tops or mid-drifts
- Shirts must be worn no more than 1” below the collar bone
- Shirts must not be loose around the neck for open gapping when bending over
- Shorts must reach past the middle finger when arms extended at sides
- Skirts must reach to touch the middle of the kneecap or lower
- No graphics/wording promoting secular bands, thoughts, or ideas
- No graphics/wording that is sarcastic in nature
- Walking shoes
