### Potential Frequently Asked Questions

### 1. What is Treehouse Worship?

Treehouse Worship is our fun, high-energy worship experience designed just for kids! Through music, storytelling, games, and engaging Bible teaching, we help kids grow in their faith in a way that's meaningful and age-appropriate.

## 2. What ages is Treehouse Worship for?

Treehouse Worship is typically designed for children in nursery to 5<sup>th</sup> grade. We group kids by age to make sure they're learning at a level that makes sense for them.

# 3. Do parents stay with their kids during Treehouse Worship?

We encourage kids to attend on their own so they can build community with peers and engage freely in the experience. However, if your child is new or a little nervous, you're more than welcome to walk them in and stay briefly to help them settle in.

#### 4. Is it safe?

Absolutely. Safety is a top priority. All of our volunteers are background-checked, safe sanctuary trained, and follow secure check-in/check-out procedures. We also maintain appropriate adult-to-child ratios to ensure each child is supervised and cared for.

### 5. What will my child learn?

Each week, kids learn a Bible story or theme, explore what it means for their lives, and discover how they can live out their faith daily. We use interactive lessons, worship songs, memory verses, and small group discussions to reinforce key takeaways.

#### 6. What if my child has special needs or requires extra support?

We strive to be inclusive and welcoming to every child. If your child has specific needs, we'd love to work with you to provide the best experience possible. Please contact us ahead of time so we can make any necessary accommodations.

#### 7. How does check-in and pick-up work?

Check-in opens 20 minutes before the service at 9:25 a.m. You'll receive matching name tags for you and your child—both are required for pick-up. Volunteers are available to help if you're checking in for the first time.

## 8. Can I volunteer or visit Treehouse Worship to see what it's like?

Yes! We love having parents and grandparents involved. Reach out to us if you're interested in serving or would like to observe a service to learn more.

# 9. Is Treehouse Worship available every week?

Yes! Treehouse Worship is offered every Sunday during our Contemporary Worship service, with occasional family services where kids join the main worship (like on Communion Sundays!).
