GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION

In high school she moved to Syracuse, NY where she met her future husband, Dr. Duret Smith. In 1982, the Smith family moved to Bay Village where they raised their two daughters, Darrah and Erica. Dorothy was a devoted wife and mother. She dedicated her life to raising her girls and was selfless in volunteering her time. It is in this spirit of giving that the Dorothy Smith Memorial Scholarships were established. It is the family's hope that the recipients of these scholarships will keep Dorothy's spirit in their hearts as they take on the next chapter in their life through continuing their education at college.

Guidelines:

1. Applicant must be a current member of Bay United Methodist Church or able to show involvement with Bay United Methodist Church life
2. Applicant must be involved in the life of the church.
3. Applicant must be enrolled in higher education, having graduated from high school
4. Applications need to be completed in a typed format and submitted prior to the deadline.
5. Awarding of scholarship will be based on the review and majority decision of the Scholarship Committee. Scholarships range from \$100-\$1000.
6. Application deadline: April 30, 2018
