- B. Big Idea: When we manage God's resources well, we are blessed and can be a blessing.
 - a. Proverbs $10:22 \text{ NLT} {}^{22}\text{ The blessing of the Lord makes a person rich,}$ and he adds no sorrow with it.
 - b. Proverbs 15:6 NLT There is treasure in the house of the godly, but the earnings of the wicked bring trouble.
- C. Scripture: Proverbs 27:23-27 NLT ²³ Know the state of your flocks, and put your heart into caring for your herds, ²⁴ for riches don't last forever, and the crown might not be passed to the next generation. ²⁵ After the hay is harvested and the new crop appears and the mountain grasses are gathered in, ²⁶ your sheep will provide wool for clothing, and your goats will provide the price of a field. ²⁷ And you will have enough goats' milk for yourself, your family, and your servant girls.
- D. How do we manage God's resources well?
 - a. Pay Attention to Resources God gives You
 - i. Psalm 24:1 NLT The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it. The world and all its people belong to him.
 - ii. Proverbs 3:9-10 NLT –.9 Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. ¹⁰ Then he will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with good wine
 - iii. Proverbs 27:23-24 NLT $-\frac{23}{5}$ Know the state of your flocks, and put your heart into caring for your herds, 24 for riches don't last forever, and the crown might not be passed to the next generation.
 - b. Get Rid of Debt
 - i. Proverbs $22:7 \text{ NLT} {}^{7} \text{ Just}$ as the rich rule the poor, so the borrower is servant to the lender.
 - ii. The Biggest Debt Traps
 - 1. Credit Cards
 - a. The average American has \$6,473 in credit card debt at \$25.32% interest.
 - b. 1 in 4 people owe \$10k or more
 - 2. Car Payments
 - a. The average car payment is \$734 for a new car and \$525 for a used car.
 - c. Save for Rainy Days and the Future Savings of 3-6 months of Expenses

- i. Matthew 5:45b NLT For he gives his sunlight to both the evil and the good, and he sends rain on the just and the unjust alike.
- ii. Proverbs $21:20 \text{ NIV} {}^{20} \text{ The wise store up choice food and olive oil, but fools gulp theirs down.}$

 - a. 33% of Americans have no savings.
 - b. 57% of American adults could not cover a \$1000 emergency.
 - c. 49% of Americans depend on credit cards just to cover essential living expenses- groceries etc
- iv. Investing Saving 15% of your income
 - 1. Proverbs 13:11 NLT ¹¹ Wealth from get-rich-quick schemes quickly disappears; wealth from hard work grows over time.
 - 2. Ecclesiastes 11:2 NLT ² But divide your investments among many places, for you do not know what risks might lie ahead.
