As St. Luke works toward finding a new Pastor to lead us, we are busy searching for Lay Leaders and ordained pastors to lead our worship services each Sunday. On July 2, Dennis Faust from St. Luke's, Obelisk will be joining us to lead worship. Dennis is a Eucharistic Minister and will be bringing consecrated communion elements which he will distribute during our worship on July 2.

Communion Cards

As you may have noticed, we're getting back to "way things used to be" at St. Luke before the pandemic. For instance, you will notice that Kathy Billger is no longer sitting in the library taking attendance!!

Attendance was taken for two reasons during the pandemic. First, it was done so that in the case of someone contracting COVID, we could check to see who was also in the congregation that day, so as to let them know that COVID might be spread among members. Also, by taking attendance, we had a record of those who took communion. The communion cards were removed from the pew racks.

Now, we no longer have that weekly record of attendance or those who take communion. You may remember that St. Luke's bylaws stipulate that members need to make a contribution of record, and take communion once every three years in order to maintain their membership at St. Luke.

Communion cards will now be on the small table in the narthex on Sundays when we celebrate communion. A jar with pencils will also be next to them. Should you need to fill out a card, feel free to do so, and place it in the offering plate. If you've been taking communion faithfully, there's no need to fill one out, as we have a record of it.
