Study of Mark

September's sermons are concentrated on the gospel of Mark. Today, Mark's gospel is among the most intensely studied of the Gospels. A significant majority of scholars consider it to have been the first Gospel written and a primary source for both Matthew and Luke. Mark writes with a powerful and energetic literary style, full of drama, mystery, and color. Like the other Gospels, he provides a unique portrait of Jesus, with a special insight into who Jesus was and what he came to accomplish.

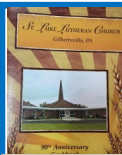
Worship & Annual Picnic

SLLC 90th Anniversary Cookbook

CRACKER CANDY

1 c. butter
1 c. brown sugar
Saltine crackers

12 oz. chocolate chips
Finely chopped nuts (opt.)

Melt butter and brown sugar in a pan, bringing it to a boil. Stir constantly for 1 to 2 minutes. In a foil-lined pan, place crackers, lined up side to side. (A jelly-roll pan works best.) Pour the mixture over the crackers and bake for 10 minutes at 375°. Take the pan out of the oven and sprinkle the chocolate chips over it. Then bake for 3 more minutes. Take the pan out of the oven and spread the mixture evenly. Sprinkle finely chopped nuts over the pan and refrigerate for 2 hours. Then turn the pan upside down on a board, removing the candy from the pan. Break the candy into pieces and store uneaten candy in a container in the refrigerator. Enjoy!

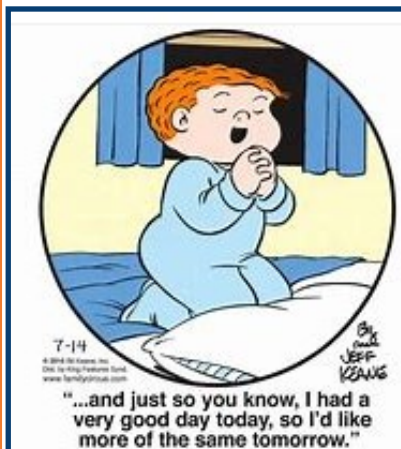
As circumstances with the virus unfold during 2022, the committee will review conditions that impact this men's event at St. Luke. Thank you for your understanding.
