
EIGHTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST



WORD

God speaks to us in scripture reading, preaching, and song.

READING:

A reading from Colossians 3:1-11

¹ So if you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. ² Set your minds on the things that are above, not on the things that are on earth, ³ for you have died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. ⁴ When Christ who is your life is revealed, then you also will be revealed with him in glory.

⁵ Put to death, therefore, whatever in you is earthly: sexual immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed (which is idolatry). ⁶ On account of these the wrath of God is coming on those who are disobedient. ⁷ These are the ways you also once followed, when you were living that life. ⁸ But now you must get rid of all such things: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive language from your mouth. ⁹ Do not lie to one another, seeing that you have stripped off the old self with its practices ¹⁰ and have clothed yourselves with the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge according to the image of its

creator. ¹¹ In that renewal there is no longer Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, enslaved and free, but Christ is all and in all!



- ³My mouth shall speak of wisdom, and my heart shall meditate on understanding.
- ⁴I will incline my ear to a proverb and set forth my riddle upon the harp.
- ⁵ Why should I be afraid in evil days, when the wickedness of those at my heels surrounds me,
- ⁶ the wickedness of those who put their trust in their own prowess, and boast of their great riches?
- ⁷One can never redeem another, or give to God the ransom for another's life;
- 8 for the ransom of a life is so great that there would never be enough to pay it,






PREFACE


LORD'S PRAYER
