This Week in Church History

4 January 1540

German Reformer Martin Luther testified in a sermon: "Faith is the 'yes' of the heart, a conviction on which one stakes one's life."

5 January 1839

Scottish clergyman Robert Murray McCheyne wrote in a letter: "There is nothing like a calm look into the eternal world to teach us the emptiness of human praise."

6 January 1850

Conversion of Charles Spurgeon who will become one of the most notable pastors of all time. He had entered a little Methodist church because of cold and snow where a deacon told him to look to Christ. "I can never tell you how it was but I no sooner saw whom I was to believe than I also understood what it was to believe and I did believe in one moment."

7 January 1868

Death in Montclair, New Jersey, of William B. Bradbury, composer of the tunes to which we sing many well-loved hymns, including "Jesus Loves Me," "Savior Like a Shepherd Lead Me," "Take My Life and Let it Be," "Sweet Hour of Prayer," "Just as I Am," and others.

8 January 1956

In Ecuador, Plymouth Brethren missionaries Jim Elliot, Nate Saint, Roger Youderian, Ed McCully and Pete Fleming were killed by the Auca Indians, while attempting to evangelize their tribe. Elliot's widow Elisabeth later published the story of their work and martyrdom in her book "Through Gates of Splendor" (1963).

9 January 710

Death of St. Adrian (or Hadrian) of Canterbury, an African. Well-educated, he had made Canterbury a center of learning for the British isles.

10 January 1947

U.S. Senate Chaplain Peter Marshall prayed: "May we resolve, God helping us, to be part of the answer, and not part of the problem."

A Commentary on Matthew 1

FAMILY WORSHIP BIBLE GUIDE - REFORMATION HERITAGE BOOKS

1. Often it is tempting to skim over the long chronologies in the Bible. However, it helps us to see that the coming of Christ was already foreseen in the Old Testament (Luke 24:44-46). When we read of Abraham, Boaz, David, Solomon, and others we see that their greater Son is now coming into the world. The time of shadows is over. The Son Himself has come.

How does this fulfilled prophecy strengthen your faith?

2. Jesus' saving work is at the forefront of the Gospels. Matthew records the angel's words, "And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins" (v. 21). Sinners of all stripes and dyes can find in this God-man a qualified and able Savior. His spotless life of obedience and His payment of the price for sin resulted in a complete and effective salvation.

Do you trust in Christ to save you from sin?

3. Though His personal name is Jesus, Christ's royal title is Emmanuel "God with us." In the person and work of Jesus, God came to dwell, or tabernacle, among His people. He did this visibly during His life on earth, but He also promises to be with His people forever (28:20).

How does Christ continue to be “God with us” even now while He is in heaven?

Elsewhere in the Bible, “Son of God,” is used to refer to angels, the nation of Israel, or to the Davidic king. But nowhere else does the Bible speak of someone being God’s “one and only Son.” Being the one and only (“begotten,” KJV) Son of God means that Jesus, unlike the rest of us, is not adopted into the family of God but is rather the eternal Son of God, the second person of the Trinity. - Kevin Vanhoozer

Question 1. *What is your only comfort in life and death?*

Answer. That I, with body and soul,^a
both in life and death,^b
am not my own,^b
but belong to my faithful Saviour Jesus Christ;^c
who, with His precious blood,^d
has fully satisfied for all my sins,^e
and delivered me from all the power of the Devil;^f
and so preserves me,^g
that without the will of my Father in heaven not a hair can fall from my
head;^h
yea, that all things must work together for my salvation.ⁱ
Wherefore, by His Holy Spirit, He also assures me of eternal life,^k
and makes me heartily willing and ready henceforth, to live unto Him.^l



Navigators Bible Reading Plan

The **Navigators Bible Reading Plan** offers special features that will aid you in your journey through the Bible.

- By reading from four separate places in the Scripture every day, you should be able to better grasp the unity of the Scriptures, as well as enjoy the variety of seeing four different viewpoints.
- You can begin at any point of the year.
- To prevent the frustration of falling behind, which most of us tend to do when following a Bible reading plan, each month of this plan gives you only twenty-five readings. Since you'll have several "free days" each month, you could set aside Sundays to either not read at all or to catch up on any readings you may have missed in the past week.
- If you finish the month's readings by the twenty-fifth, you could use the final days of the month to study the passages that challenged or intrigued you.
- If reading through the entire Bible in one year looms as too large a task, you can alter the plan to meet your needs. For example, you could read the gospels and the wisdom books this year, and the other two categories next year.

In the year ahead, ask God each day to speak directly to you from the Scripture portions you read. Be expectant, and let your continual exposure to God's Word reshape your attitudes and behavior as you gain a better understanding of every part of His written testimony to us.
