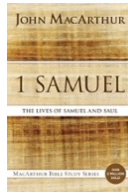


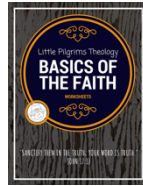

So then: Repent, Believe, and Follow the Lord Jesus Christ.

Question 27. *What do you understand by the providence of God?*

Answer: The almighty and everywhere present power of God,^a whereby, as it were by His hand, He still upholds heaven and earth, with all creatures;^b and so governs them, that herbs and grass, rain and drought, fruitful and barren years,^c meat and drink,^d health and sickness,^e riches and poverty,^f yea, all things, come not by chance, but by his fatherly hand.^g

Answer: That we may be patient in adversity;^a thankful in prosperity;^b and for what is future, have good confidence in our faithful God and Father, that no creature shall separate us from His love;^c since all creatures are so in His hand, that without His will they cannot so much as move.^d

8 March 2009

Angered at Christian conversions of Hindus, Rajesh Singh tosses a bomb into a House of Prayer church in Bihar state, India, and then shoots pastor Vinod Kumar, who will survive.

9 March 1843

Scottish clergyman Robert Murray McCheyne wrote in a letter: "You will never find Jesus so precious as when the world is one vast howling wilderness. Then he is like a rose blooming in the midst of the desolation, a rock rising above the storm."

10 March 1748

John Newton, 22, a sailor on a slave ship, is converted to Christianity during a huge storm at sea. He eventually becomes an Anglican clergyman, the author of the famous hymn 'Amazing Grace' and a zealous abolitionist. "That 10th of March is a day much to be remembered by me; ...For on that day the Lord came from on high and delivered me out of deep waters."

11 March 2005

Turkey's Directorate of Religious Affairs requires 75,000 mosques to preach a sermon this day advising Muslims that Christian missionaries present a danger to national unity and integrity.

12 March 1607

Birth of Paul Gerhardt, German clergyman and hymnwriter. He lost four of his five children in childhood, yet also composed over 130 hymns, including 'O Sacred Head, Now Wounded.' (Gerhardt's music marks the transition in Lutheran hymnody from confessional and high-church hymns to hymns of devotional piety.)

13 March 1925

Tennessee Governor Austin Peay signed legislation prohibiting the teaching of evolution within the state's public school system. (A violation of this law led to the July Scopes Monkey Trial.)

14 March 1937

English Bible expositor Arthur W. Pink wrote in a letter: "Neither the nearness nor the remoteness of Christ's return is a rule to regulate us in the ordering of our temporal affairs. Spiritual preparedness is the great matter."
