This Week in Church History

WHY STUDY CHURCH HISTORY?

Church history is the story of how God has guarded, purified, chastised, and strengthened His undeserving people. God has unique purposes for His church.

26 July 1833

Friends bring a dying William Wilberforce good news: a bill for the abolition of slavery had passed its second reading in Parliament, assuring its passage. For four decades, he had fought hard to abolish slavery throughout the British Empire. He dies 3 days later.

27 July 1681

Scottish Covenanter preacher Donald Cargill is hanged for his faith in Edinburgh.

28 July 1881

Birthday of J. Gresham Machen. He would become a staunch defender of the Bible as true, and would argue against theological liberalism. A champion of traditional Calvinism, Machen would be a principal founder of Westminster Seminary in Philadelphia (1929).

29 July 1030

King Olaf II of Norway fell in battle on this day. While professing true faith, and credited with many religious reforms in Norway; he is perhaps best known for many forced conversions and forced baptisms.

30 July 1547

John Knox is captured by the French. He had become the chaplain of the killers of Cardinal Beaton of St. Andrews. When the French capture their castle, he is sentenced to the galleys. Eventually he will escape the galleys to become a leader of the Scottish Reformation.

31 July 1889

Death of Horatius Bonar. An editor and pastor in Scotland's Free Church, he had been a prolific writer and poet, authoring several missionary biographies and over six hundred hymns, one of which would maintain its popularity for over a century: "I Heard the Voice of Jesus Say."

1 August 1834

Death of missionary Robert Morrison at age 52. The first English Protestant missionary to China, he had translated the Bible into Chinese, constructed a Chinese grammar, founded an Anglo-Chinese college, and edited a six-volume Chinese dictionary.

Heidelberg Catechism¹⁵⁶³ | Lord's Day 30

Question 80. *What difference is there between the Lord's Supper and the Popish Mass?*

Answer: The Lord's Supper testifies to us, that we have full forgiveness of all our sins by the one sacrifice of Jesus Christ, which He Himself has once accomplished on the cross;^a and that by the Holy Ghost we are ingrafted into Christ,^b who with His true body is now in heaven at the right hand of the Father,^c and is to be there worshipped.^d But the Mass teaches, that the living and the dead have not forgiveness of sins through the sufferings of Christ, unless Christ is still daily offered for them by the priests; and that Christ is bodily under the form of bread and wine, and is therefore to be worshipped in them. [And thus the Mass at bottom is nothing else but a denial of the one sacrifice and passion of Jesus Christ, and an accursed idolatry.]*

Question 81. *Who are to come unto the table of the Lord?*

Answer: Those who are displeased with themselves for their sins,^a yet trust that these are forgiven them, and that their remaining infirmity is covered by the passion and death of Christ;^b and who also desire more and more to strengthen their faith and amend their life.^c But the impenitent and hypocrites eat and drink judgment to themselves.^d

Question 82. *Are they then also to be admitted to this Supper, who show themselves to be, by their confession and life, unbelieving and ungodly?*

Answer: No: for by this the covenant of God is profaned, and His wrath provoked against the whole congregation;^a wherefore the Christian church is bound, according to the order of Christ and His apostles, by the office of the keys to exclude such persons, until they amend their life.^b
