### A Commentary on Micah 6:

#### FAMILY WORSHIP BIBLE GUIDE - REFORMATION HERITAGE BOOKS

1. Although the court session Micah records concerned ancient Israel, the trial issues are universal and timeless. Religion in one form or another dominated life and in many ways blinded the people to the problem of sin. Religious people are often the hardest to convict of sin because they assume that they are doing what God wants.

Many today without Christ assume that going to church and keeping the Golden Rule will somehow balance to their favor in the end. Even many who profess Christ allow their pious routines to substitute for private devotion and a sincere heart.

The Scripture is explicitly clear that God has never been and will never be satisfied with external religion or empty profession without a true heart of faith on the inside that authenticates itself by true holiness on the outside. The link between behavior and belief is the essence of true religion (James 1:27).

2. Unquestionably Christ referred to verse 8 when He exposed the hypocrisy of the Pharisees by accusing them of omitting the most important matters of the law: judgment, mercy, and faith (Matt. 23:23).

What condemned the Jews of Micah's day condemned the Pharisees of Christ's day. Indeed, the requirements of true religion never change, and God's requirement of what is good remains the standard for today.

That Micah uses a court scene to make his point reminds us of a coming day of judgment when all hearts will be open and naked before the eyes of Him to whom we will answer.

The verdicts rendered on that day are eternal, so it behooves us all "to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with [our] God."

#### THE LORD'S SUPPER

Elder: Beloved in the Lord Jesus Christ, the meal which we are about to celebrate is a feast of

remembrance, confession, and hope. We come to remember that Jesus was sent into the world to

take on flesh and blood and bear the wrath of God for sin. Why has God done this?

People: To glorify Himself and to redeem us by His sacrifice.

Elder: Is this meal for all people?

People: It is for all who trust in Jesus Christ alone as Savior

and honor Him as Lord.

Elder: It is for followers of Christ who confess, affirm, and proclaim: All: I believe in God the Father Almighty,

Maker of heaven and earth:

And in Jesus Christ His only begotten Son, our Lord;

who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,

born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and buried;

He descended into hell;

the third day He rose again from the dead;

He ascended into heaven,

and sitteth on the right hand of God the Father Almighty; From thence He shall come to judge

the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit; One Holy Christian Church; the communion of saints; the forgiveness of sins; the resurrection of the body; and the life everlasting.

Elder: The bread and the cup in this meal are a picture of the new covenant relationship that God

propitiated for us, through the costly suffering and sacrifice of His one and only begotten Son.

People: May we be filled with new life and new desires as we

remember the cost of our salvation.

Elder: Let us also be aware of a warning from scripture: Whoever, therefore, eats the bread or drinks

the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner, without a full repentance of all sin, will be guilty of profaning the body and blood of the Lord. Examine yourselves, repent, and then eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For anyone who eats and drinks without pursuing a life of obedience, eats and drinks judgment on themselves (1 Corinthians 11). You can be sure His blood washes away your sin when your converted life and humbled heart prove Him to be your Lord and Savior.

People: I will examine myself with scripture, repent, and obey before

eating and drinking. May God work powerfully in our lives!

Please review the notes on the back before you partake of the Lord's Supper.

#### **GUIDELINES FOR THE LORD'S SUPPER**

Please know that partaking of the Lord's Supper is not something to be taken lightly and is scripturally for repenting believers only. If you are struggling with some specific sin in your life, and are actively fighting against sin, let this meal help strengthen you in your fight.

If however you are "not struggling" in your struggle against sin (ongoing adultery, homosexuality, living together before marriage, etc...) you should refrain from taking the elements. Living in open disobedience to the Lord and His word is inconsistent to a converted life that has been changed by an understanding of the cross. This meal is for believers and followers who will sin, but they are repenting of their sin, and working to not sin again.

If you feel you are not ready to participate today, please do not feel embarrassed by passing the elements on as they arrive to you. We thank you in advance for respecting God's word and respecting the church's mandate to do all things according to God's word.

If though during the course of this gathering you have felt a call, a desire, or have had a change of heart, and are desiring to live a life of full obedience to the Lord from this day forward, prayerfully repent of your sin, and we gladly invite you to this table today!

If you are a visitor here today and usually partake of The Lord's Supper in your home church, and if your home church is likeminded in the preaching the gospel as you have heard here today, we gladly welcome you to partake of the elements here!

We encourage parents to take responsibility for the decision of whether children should partake. Children (like adults) should understand sin is any offense (thought, word, or deed) against God. The penalty for sin is God's judgment and ultimately hell. All people are in need of a savior because of our rebellion and sin.

Children (like adults) should also understand and affirm that what saves us from God's judgment and hell is the work of Christ alone. Jesus lived a sinless life, He died on the cross in our place, He rose from the dead, and He is coming back again to redeem His chosen bride (followers/the church). Because we are saved by Christ, we then in turn away from sin and are granted a new life in Christ. The desire to actively live an obedient life takes root consistent with scripture because the Holy Spirit enters and convicts us of remaining sin and enables us to live changed and obedient lives.
