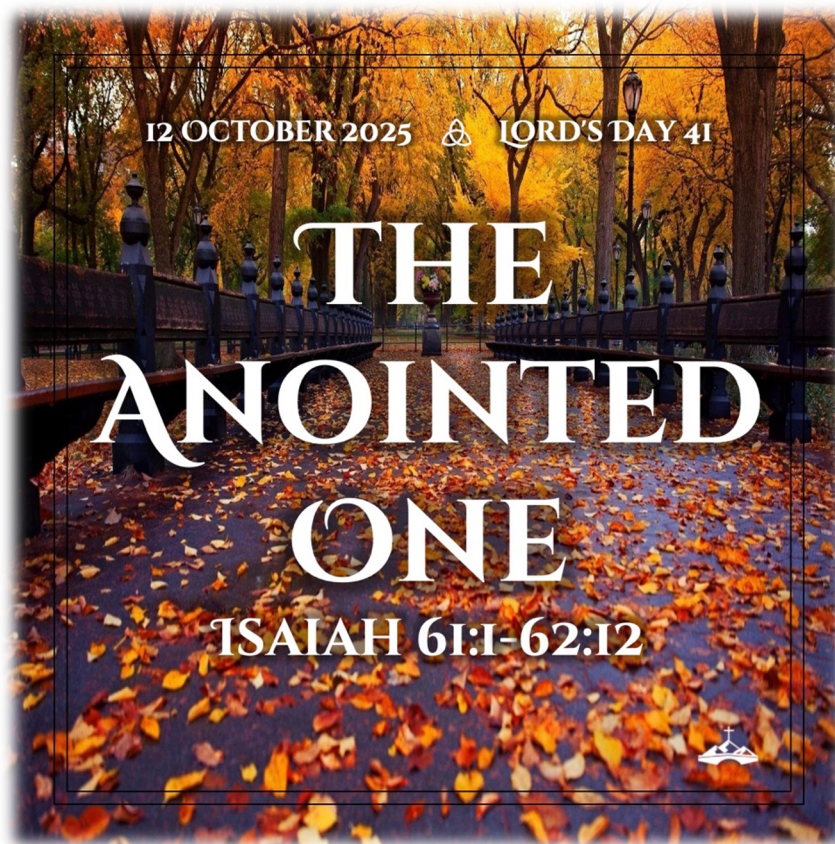

THE FIVE SOLAS OF THE REFORMATION - 1517 SOLA GRATIA

"It is grace alone expressed through the supernatural work of the Holy Spirit that brings us to Christ, releasing us from our bondage to sin and raising us from death to spiritual life." - James Boice

The doctrine of sola gratia - **grace alone** - reminds us that our salvation is entirely a gift of grace from God. This concept of unmerited favor stands in stark contrast to any notion that we can merit salvation - in part or in whole - by our own works.

This of course does not mean that we should live lives of depravity because we are saved by this gift of grace. Rather, we are to pursue lives of holiness in accordance to the Scriptures, giving thanks to our gracious God.

A Commentary on Isaiah 61 & 62

FAMILY WORSHIP BIBLE GUIDE - REFORMATION HERITAGE BOOKS

Chapter 61

In considering the wonder of salvation, Isaiah breaks forth with rejoicing (v.10), and we should as well. Christ's blood has cleansed us and clothed us in the garments of salvation. We have been covered with the robe of righteousness, which is Christ Himself. So when God the Father looks upon us, wretched, unworthy sinners as we are, He remembers our sins no more and instead sees the absolute perfection of Christ covering us. Beloved in Christ, how blessed we are! Believers ought to praise God with joyful adoration. We should draw near to the Lord with boldness, for Christians are priests in Christ.

How can you use this chapter as fuel for heartfelt praise?

Chapter 62

One of the most beautiful pictures given to us of Christ's relationship with His people is that of a marriage of mutual love and delight (v. 4-5). Salvation is not just a matter of legal verdicts and rescue from danger but of bringing people to the Lord so that He may love them forever. One of the fruits of the Spirit is joy in the Lord.

How should the Christian life reflect this spiritual marriage?

Isaiah 61-62 ^{ESV}

61 The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the poor; he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound;

² to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all who mourn;

³ to grant to those who mourn in Zion— to give them a beautiful headdress instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, the garment of praise instead of a faint spirit; that they may be called oaks of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that he may be glorified.

⁴ They shall build up the ancient ruins; they shall raise up the former devastations; they shall repair the ruined cities, the devastations of many generations.

⁵ Strangers shall stand and tend your flocks; foreigners shall be your plowmen and vinedressers;

⁶ but you shall be called the priests of the Lord; they shall speak of you as the ministers of our God; you shall eat the wealth of the nations, and in their glory you shall boast.

⁷ Instead of your shame there shall be a double portion; instead of dishonor they shall rejoice in their lot; therefore in their land they shall possess a double portion; they shall have everlasting joy.

⁸ For I the Lord love justice; I hate robbery and wrong; I will faithfully give them their recompense, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them.

⁹ Their offspring shall be known among the nations, and their descendants in the midst of the peoples; all who see them shall acknowledge them, that they are an offspring the Lord has blessed.

¹⁰ I will greatly rejoice in the Lord; my soul shall exult in my God, for he has clothed me with the garments of salvation; he has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself like a priest with a beautiful headdress, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

¹¹ For as the earth brings forth its sprouts, and as a garden causes what is sown in it to sprout up, so the Lord God will cause righteousness and praise to sprout up before all the nations.

⁶²¹ For Zion's sake I will not keep silent, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not be quiet, until her righteousness goes forth as brightness, and her salvation as a burning torch.

² The nations shall see your righteousness, and all the kings your glory, and you shall be called by a new name that the mouth of the Lord will give.

³ You shall be a crown of beauty in the hand of the Lord, and a royal diadem in the hand of your God.

⁴ You shall no more be termed Forsaken, and your land shall no more be termed Desolate, but you shall be called My Delight Is in Her, and your land Married; for the Lord delights in you, and your land shall be married.

⁵ For as a young man marries a young woman, so shall your sons marry you, and as the bridegroom rejoices over the bride, so shall your God rejoice over you.

⁶ On your walls, O Jerusalem, I have set watchmen; all the day and all the night they shall never be silent. You who put the Lord in remembrance, take no rest,

⁷and give him no rest until he establishes Jerusalem and makes it a praise in the earth.

⁸ The Lord has sworn by his right hand and by his mighty arm: “I will not again give your grain to be food for your enemies, and foreigners shall not drink your wine for which you have labored;

⁹ but those who garner it shall eat it and praise the Lord, and those who gather it shall drink it in the courts of my sanctuary.”

¹⁰ Go through, go through the gates; prepare the way for the people; build up, build up the highway; clear it of stones; lift up a signal over the peoples.

¹¹ Behold, the Lord has proclaimed to the end of the earth: Say to the daughter of Zion, “Behold, your salvation comes; behold, his reward is with him, and his recompense before him.”

¹² And they shall be called The Holy People, The Redeemed of the Lord; and you shall be called Sought Out, A City Not Forsaken.
