

### THE FIVE SOLAS OF THE REFORMATION - 1517 SOLI DEO GLORIA

"God is glorified not only by His glory being seen, but by its being rejoiced in."
-Jonathan Edwards

The doctrine of soli deo gloria - glory to God alone - teaches that all glory is due to God alone and no other. This glory is due Him because from Him and through Him and to Him are all things, including our salvation.

God created us for His glory and saved us for His glory. We of course do not add to His glory, but participate in its fullness, for who could add to an already perfect glory?

This doctrine serves as a nice bookend to the previous four solas as well, since God brings salvation to His people through the work of Christ alone, given to us by grace alone, received to us by faith alone, and promised to us by Scripture alone.

## A Commentary on Isaiah 64

FAMILY WORSHIP BIBLE GUIDE - REFORMATION HERITAGE BOOKS

The Lord's presence and power ought to be the desire of every believer. There are times when the Lord seems to have hidden His face from us, and that ought to drive us to prayer, as it did Isaiah.

In the previous chapter the prophet prayed for God to look down from heaven (63:15). Now he prays for God to tear the heavens apart and come down. We should plead with God to remove every impediment to knowing the fullness of His presence. Things will be remarkably different when God appears in His glory and power.

Let us wait upon the Lord, earnestly expecting Him to bless His people, that by faith in the gospel we may see what God "hath prepared for him that waiteth for him" (v. 4).

How does this kind of prayer seek awakening and revival by the Holy Spirit? How does it ultimately seek nothing less than the return of Christ?

### Today in Christian History

#### 366

One hundred and thirty seven of Ursinius's followers are massacred in their Basilica by Damasus's supporters in one of the battles that ensued after rival popes were elected.

#### 899

(Probable date) Death of Alfred the Great, ruler of Wessex, England. His defeat of the Danes ensured Christianity's survival in England, but he is also known for his ecclesiastical reforms and his efforts to revive learning in his country.

### 1633

The Puritan congregation at Newton (now Cambridge), Massachusetts, chooses Thomas Hooker as its pastor. Hooker had fled persecution in England.

### 1775

Phillis Wheatley, a slave in Boston who has written Christian poems, sends George Washington a few lines in which she describes him as "first in peace and honors."

## Isaiah 63:15-64:12 ESV

- <sup>63:15</sup> Look down from heaven and see, from your holy and beautiful habitation. Where are your zeal and your might? The stirring of your inner parts and your compassion are held back from me.
- <sup>16</sup> For you are our Father, though Abraham does not know us, and Israel does not acknowledge us; you, O Lord, are our Father, our Redeemer from of old is your name.
- <sup>17</sup>O Lord, why do you make us wander from your ways and harden our heart, so that we fear you not? Return for the sake of your servants, the tribes of your heritage.
- <sup>18</sup>Your holy people held possession for a little while; our adversaries have trampled down your sanctuary.
- $^{19}$  We have become like those over whom you have never ruled, like those who are not called by your name.
- <sup>64:1</sup> Oh that you would rend the heavens and come down, that the mountains might quake at your presence—
- <sup>2</sup> as when fire kindles brushwood and the fire causes water to boil— to make your name known to your adversaries, and that the nations might tremble at your presence!
- <sup>3</sup>When you did awesome things that we did not look for, you came down, the mountains quaked at your presence.
