We are very excited to update our church service plan! Beginning July 18th, 2021 LA County will once again be requiring facemasks for all indoor spaces. For those who are fully vaccinated and comfortable, one side of the sanctuary will allow selection of seating (no longer enforcing 'social distance'). The other section, will have excluded pews for those who may not feel quite so comfortable (continuing to be fully distanced.) As always, we will continue to record the message and post them to our [church website](#) for those unable to attend, for whatever reason. These will be uploaded and available that same Sunday afternoon (usually by about 2 pm.)

Please realize that this change does **not** however represent a complete 'return to normal', unlike Sundays before all of this began, some adjustments will remain in place. For the time being, we will continue to collect offering using the deposit boxes and all-in-one communion cups will be used instead of passing trays.

We are excited to announce that **midweek Bible study will resume on July 6th, 2021!** Every Tuesday at 7 p.m., we will be going through ***The Story, Getting to the Heart of God's Story*** by Randee Frazee. In this curriculum, we will look at the Bible as one complete text, examining the message, truth and threads that are weaved through from Genesis to Revelation.
