Honig Scholarship Notice Beginning Feb. 1st

Evelyn Honig, a former Westminster member, established in her will a scholarship trust fund to be administered through Westminster Presbyterian Church. Honig Scholarship application forms for the 2020-2021 academic years are available upon written request sent to the Honig Scholarship Committee in care of Westminster Presbyterian Church, P.O. Box 1258, Bluefield, WV 24701.

The Scholarship Administration Form cover letter spells out the qualification requirements and procedures. It is required that applicants are a **resident of Bluefield, West Virginia**. While the deadline is June 15, the committee wants to alert prospective qualified high school graduates and prior recipients to submit application forms each year. The Honig Scholarship Committee will evaluate all the requests to determine eligibility and amounts of awards available in accordance with Mrs. Honig's will and trust fund.
