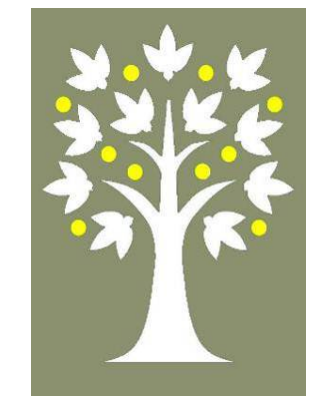

The church is collecting socks, hats and gloves for the Union Mission. Donations can be placed in the blue container across from the church office.

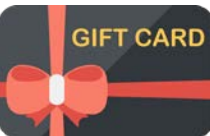
