



Tami Snowden: Training in Ethiopia Continues:

Our first visit to Ethiopia was in 2016 to teach at the Evangelical Theological College (ETC). We returned to Ethiopia in 2018 for more training, and continue to partner with them to teach students. Most of the students are already in fulltime ministry working with at-risk children.



There Is Hope For Me, our Trauma Recovery Booklet for children continues to be used worldwide. We are currently working on translations in Burmese, Thai, Mongolian and a revision of our Arabic version. This booklet is an amazing tool to help children and youth work through trauma. Please pray for this important work that the translation will be finished soon.

Ukraine: Mission Eurasia asked if we could create a Sunday School Curriculum based on There Is Hope For Me and it is almost finished! Please pray that it is ready to be distributed to Ukrainian churches this Spring.

The director of Children's Ministries among Baptist Churches in Ukraine told our contact with Mission Eurasia that she wants trauma training for her network of Sunday School teachers. The training would reach 24 regional leaders and 1500 Sunday School teachers. Since electricity is an ongoing issue in Ukraine, please pray for stable reception so we can provide this training via Zoom in late spring/early summer.

As the number of hurting and traumatized children in the world continues to rise, Tami asks us to pray that children will know they have a God who loves them deeply. Pray for those who have children in crisis to be equipped to help them heal from trauma and come to know God as loving and protective Father.
