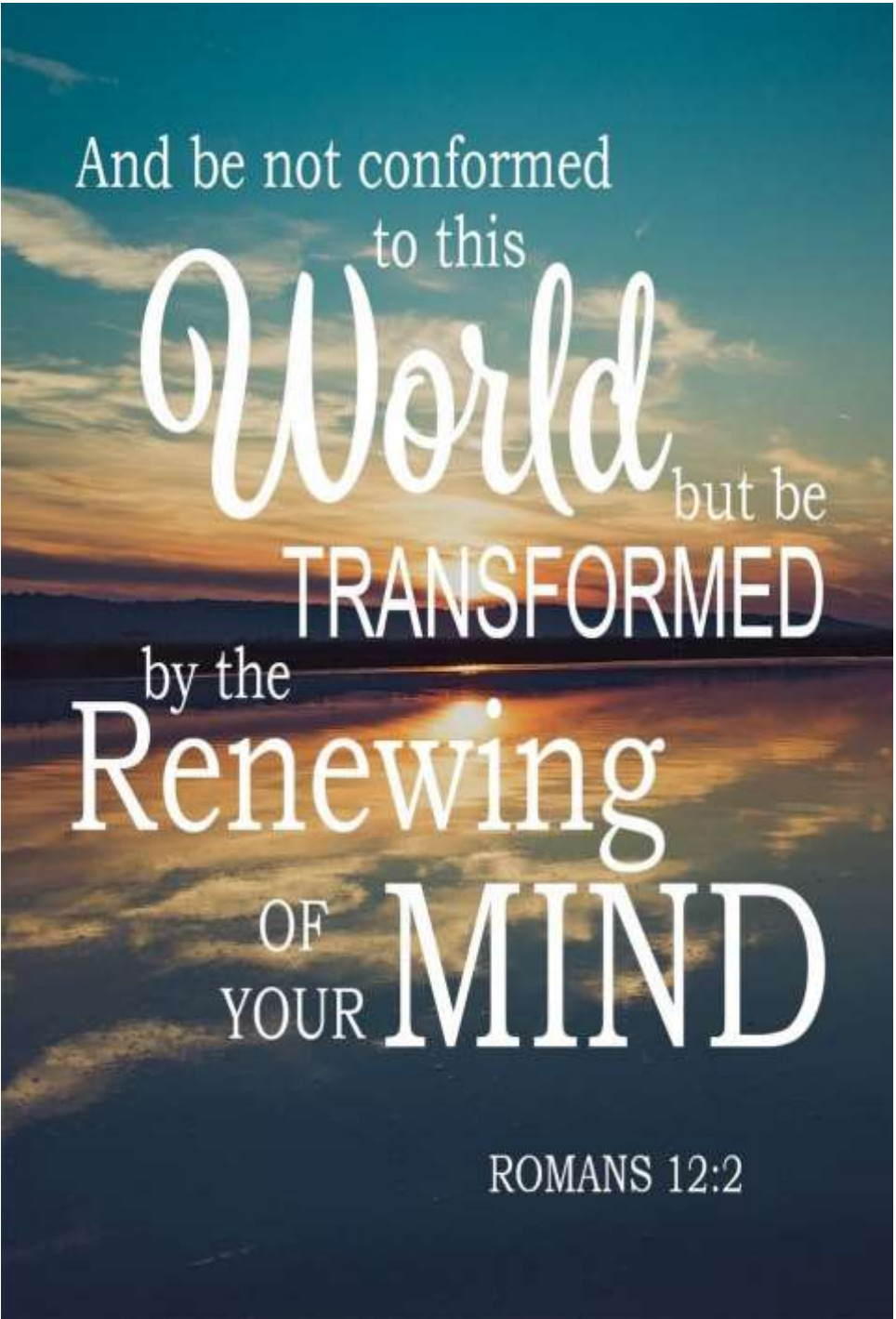
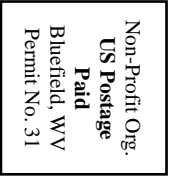

Update from Rich



I___ Trip (June 17-July 2)

Week 1, June 19-23: Level 2 (Advanced) Group in North I___. I will be facilitating the second part of the advanced course on Psalms that I began in March.

Week 2, June 26-30: South I___. After nearly five years' pause, I reopened work there in March's trip. K, my interpreter there, is the key man, organizing and hosting this seminar. This group has rural pastors, church planters, and women's ministry leaders; some are working among unreached minority groups (called “tribals” in I....). As this will be only the second seminar for them, prayer is especially needed.

- General requests:
- As always, please remember to ask God for safety, good health and stamina for me, and protection from any interference or hindrance from the enemy or from human authorities.
 - The weather is usually very hot, humid, and rainy in late June; pray that it won't hinder us! Pray that the interpreters and Rich communicate with each other and the students so that the teaching is clear and understood.
 - Pray for God's provision to cover the extra costs in this trip (travel costs are up considerably).
