

### **Azim and Anara:**

Our trip to Turkey for the conference was a great gift. For the first time in our lives. we left the country with the whole family. My family and Anara's family, in which we grew up, did not leave their cities, from the country. I am glad that my children will have a different experience. We were impressed by how safe and protected people there are, so their energy is directed towards creation, not survival. The trip was a great contribution to our parenthood, in particular - my fatherhood. I was very proud to be able to take care of myself and my family. Thank you very much for making our trip possible.

Last year I buried my father, and my mother was left alone. And as the youngest son, according to the Uighur tradition, I need to live with my mother and take care of her. Due to the lack of social protection in Asian families, vounger sons take care of their parents in old age. This way of life is passed down from generation to generation and has deep roots for the Asian. For the sake of survival, children do not leave the parental home, but live in the same house for several generations. Children in an Asian family are perceived as an investment project in which adults invest their youth in order to receive big dividends in old age.

I do not believe in the beliefs of my large family and culture, I believe that we come into the world by the will of God, and not just by the will of our parents. I believe that separation is necessary for a fulfilling life, and Jesus redeemed us from guilt. God has blessed me with the strength to get out of this system. I try to live separately from my parents. But recently God has shown me that I have a deep sense of guilt due to separation from the worldview, beliefs of my culture and family. I saw that a lot of my life energy is spent on fighting guilt. I myself have not yet fully realized how deep the roots of these false beliefs are in me, but I really want to be free! Not just beautifully preaching about freedom in Christ, but experiencing it on a deep level. Continue to be a part of your culture, a large family, live among Asians, but have deep convictions that give freedom and direct the energy of life to create the future.
