



## World Outreach Update from Phil Thrash

From a recent trip to Germany (which is only 1.5% Christian!), Phil reported this incident:

"I met again with David B. of Operation Mobilization in Berlin that is almost completely Muslim. I was on the street with them praying around the area, singing worship songs to passersby and handed out a Gospel of John in Farsi to an Afghan man. David was glad I and others were praying as he had an incident with a Turkish man who was screaming at him and to anyone who would listen trying to create a scene. As we prayed and took authority over the evil that was apparently bothering the man, he miraculously stopped, went to a juice stand,



bought David an orange juice, handed it to him and shook his hand giving a formal German good-bye. I could hardly believe my eyes. We all agreed the enemy had sent someone to distract David and others and drain his energy. Praise the Lord, he intervened... God's reaching the lost, and we are all so excited that we get to partner with him.:)"
