**This week read: Matthew 14:13-21; Mark 6:30-44;
Luke 9:10-17; Luke 7:36-50; Ezekiel 34**

- Why do you think the compassion of Jesus is so appealing?
- Which kind of sheep have you identified with most and why? Weak, sick, injured, stray or lost?
- How has the Lord brought healing to you?
- What kind of sheep do you see yourself as now? What do you need to be made whole again?
- In Luke 7, Jesus asks Simon, “Do you see this woman?” Are there individuals who you have come across that Jesus has asked you the same thing of? How have you responded?
- In the feeding of the 5000, when Jesus sees “the crowd” He has compassion on them. When you see “the crowds” is your initial reaction compassion? What should the reaction of our church be?
- How have you responded when Jesus has said, “You give them something to eat” ?
- How does the principle of “little is much in the hands of Jesus” speak to you?
- Are there “little things” in your life that you have held back from offering to the Lord because you didn’t think He could do anything with them?
- What can we learn from the feeding of the 5000?
