#### **Wednesday—Read Matthew 26:31-46**

When do you pray? What do you pray about? Have you ever prayed when you were scared?

#### **Thursday—Read Matthew 26:47-56**

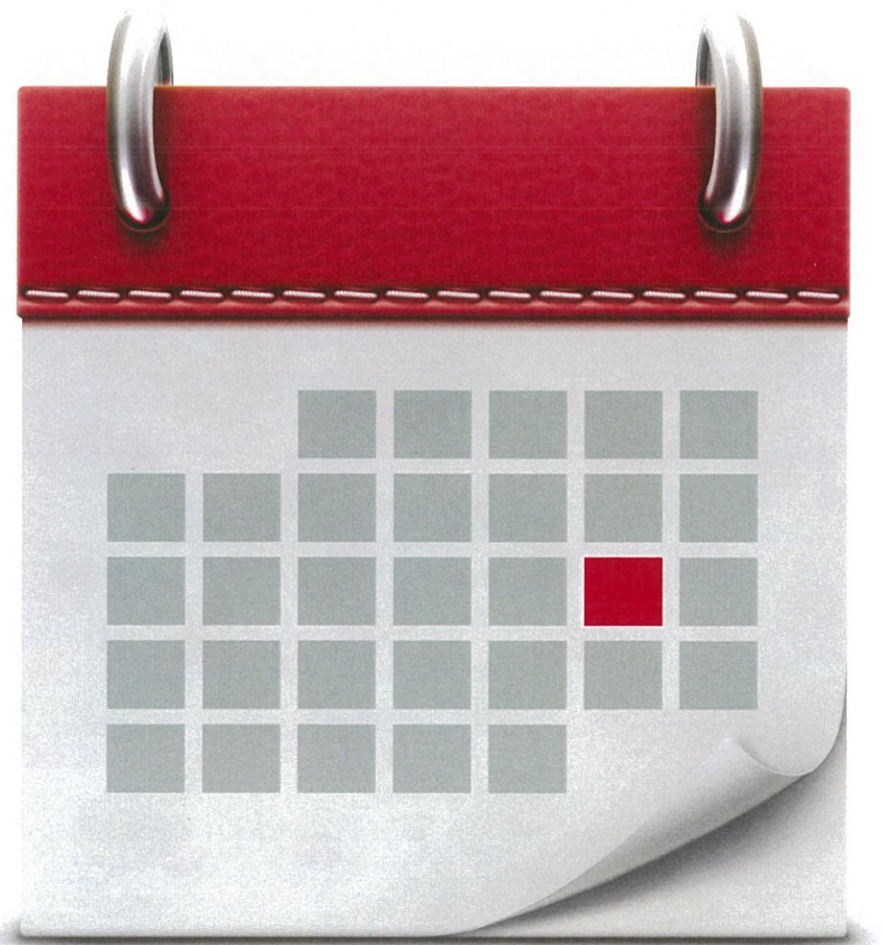
Why do you think the disciples ran away?
