

Date: December 2, 2018 (14)

Scripture Passage: *He who calls you is faithful; he will surely do it. —1 Thessalonians 5:24*

Lesson Theme: *Amazingly, God had made this wonderful promise in the midst of Adam and Eve's failure—a promise to send a perfect Deliverer to crush the power of Satan, sin, and death. And throughout the Old Testament we see the extraordinary faithfulness of God as He keeps promise after promise, pointing forward and culminating in the long-awaited arrival of the Deliverer—Jesus, the Holy Son of God. God always keeps His promises!*

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Will God stop being faithful just because people do not like a certain promise?
- 2) Because God is always faithful, how should we act toward Him?
- 3) Should we pay attention to His warning promises?

Lesson Theme: *God is three persons in one God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.*

Family Discussion Questions:

1. Because there is only one true God, how should we act toward Him?
2. Do people sometimes treat Jesus as if He were just an ordinary person and not really God?
3. Why is it important to know that there is only one true God?

Scripture Passage: *[He] is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of kings and Lord of lords. —1 Timothy 6:15b*

Lesson Theme: *God is self-sufficiency, eternal and triune nature, almighty power, wisdom, sovereign rule, righteous character, etc. It makes perfect sense that God would delight in all that He is and does. He is the happiest being in the universe! And, to our utter amazement, He has chosen to share the overflow of His own happiness with His creation, especially with His chosen people.*

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Have you ever thought of God as being happy, the happiest Person in the whole universe? Why is it good news to know the truth that God is happy?
- 2) What is the "path of life" that God has shown to us?
- 3) Why would God be the only One able to make us happy—truly happy—forever?
