Scripture Passage: Matthew 19:4-6; Ephesians 5:22-29; Psalm 78:5-7; Proverbs 1:8

Lesson Theme: Marriage is God's design to join one man and woman together with their complementary roles for a lifelong commitment. Marriage shows the faithful relationship that Jesus has with His bride, the church where His people joyfully submit to Him. Marriage allows for the wonderful gift and responsibility of having and training children to follow Jesus as children honor and obey their parents.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What steps can you make this week to better honor and obey your parents?
- 2) How do you see God's plan for marriage being lived out in your family or a family you know?
- 3) How can you be praying for your parents and family this week?

Date: December 9, 2018

Scripture Passage: Acts 19:26-27; 1 Timothy 3:14-15; Titus 2:1; 1 Peter 2:9; John 14:6

Lesson Theme: The true church includes all Christians and upholds the truth of God's Word. The church has a responsibility to uphold the truth through teaching, proclaiming, guarding, and demonstrating God's Word.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) How can you better use the resources God has blessed you with to grow closer to Him?
- 2) How can you better guard the truth this week in your lives?
- 3) What scripture passage can help strengthen you to defend and proclaim the truth of God's word?

Date: December 16, 2018

Scripture Passage: Genesis 1:26-27; Acts 17:25; 1 Corinthians 10:31; Romans 3:23; 6:23

Lesson Theme: The Bible is the only true lens through which we see and understand ourselves. Our value and worth comes from God and is not self-derived. We are completely dependent on God for everything and exist to glorify Him. Only through Jesus can we rightly see and live to glorify God.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Who do you need to share these truths with this week?
- 2) How does this change the way you view yourselves and others?
- 3) What areas of your life do you need to encourage greater God-esteem in your life?
