Scripture Passage: *My son, do not despise the LORD's discipline or be weary of his reproof, 12for the LORD reproves him whom he loves, as a father the son in whom he delights. —Proverbs 3:11-12*

Lesson Theme: God disciplines those He loves, for our good.

Family Discussion Questions:

Date: February 11, 2018 Review

Scripture Passage: Review

Lesson Theme: Your child will review over the past several week what they have learnt.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What is one verse that you remember
- 2) What is one story that you remember?
- 3) How are you different?

Date: February 18, 2018 (21)

Scripture Passage: *For I know the plans I have for you, declares the LORD, plans for wholeness and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope. —Jeremiah 29:11 (ESV, 2003)*

Lesson Theme: God's plans for His children are for good.

Family Discussion Questions:

1. Is there a difference between what is easy for you and what is good for you?
2. Do God's plans for good for His children mean "easy" for them?
3. Why is it more loving to do what is good for people than what is easy for people?

Date: February 25, 2018 (22)

Scripture Passage: *When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you;...—Isaiah 43:2a*

Lesson Theme: Christians will have troubles, but God promises to be with them in the hard times.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Does the promise that God will deliver the righteous out of all their afflictions mean that God will change the circumstances to be good?
- 2) What does it mean?
- 3) Why is God knowing His children by name so comforting?
