**Family Discussion Questions:**

3. Even a seemingly small or ordinary ability?

**Scripture Passage:** *"but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. 21 For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."*—Matthew 6:20-21

**Lesson Theme:** Everything done in loving obedience to Jesus will reap a heavenly reward.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) How would you feel if it broke an earthly possession and you couldn't replace it?
- 2) What if it were stolen?
- 3) Do you think you will still like it when you are 20 years old?
