Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) How are followers of Jesus different than those in the world?
- 2) How can we deal with the trials of this life?
- 3) What can we do to represent Christ in our daily lives?

Date: February 25, 2018

Scripture Passage: 2 Corinthians 2:14-16, Matthew 5:13, John 17:14-18, 2 Timothy 2:22--24

Lesson Theme: Christians are called to share the Gospel, sharing the hope of Jesus with everyone.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) How can we influence the people around us for good?
- 2) What are ways we can encourage other believers?
- 3) Who in our lives can we specifically share the Gospel with?
