

Date: July 1, 2018 (37)

Scripture Passage: *And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ. —Philippians 1:6*

Lesson Theme: God is faithful and will surely empower His children to persevere to the end.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Read Luke 8:15; Colossians 1:23a; 2 Timothy 4:7-8; Philippians 1:6; and 1 Corinthians 1:8-9. Identify the action words in the verses. Which words describe actions for believers, and which describe God acting?
- 2) If you are trusting in Jesus, was it you that began the work of salvation in your life?
- 3) Why is that important for us to know? How should this greatly humble and encourage every believer?

Date: July 8, 2018 (38)

Scripture Passage: *But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, 21 who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself. —Philippians 3:20-21*

Lesson Theme: Jesus has promised to transform His people and give them glorified bodies after death.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Have you ever imagined what it would be like to have a perfect body, one that never gets hurt or sick?
- 2) No more disabilities of any kind?
- 3) Have you ever imagined what it would be like to never have to be afraid, lonely, frustrated, sad, envious, or angry?

Date: July 15, 2018 (39)

Scripture Passage: *I give thanks to you, O Lord my God, with my whole heart, and I will glorify your name forever.— Psalm 86:12*

Lesson Theme: We were created in a special way for a special purpose—to glorify God forever.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Read Psalm 86:12. Talk about what is meant by the term “with my whole heart.”?
- 2) Could anyone honestly say that any of us already loves, thanks, praises, honors, and glorifies God with our whole heart? Why not?
- 3) But for everyone who is trusting in Jesus for salvation, what has He promised?

Date: July 22, 2018 (40)

Scripture Passage *“I am the vine, you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing.”—John 15:5*

Lesson Theme: The Christian life involves coming to Jesus, looking to Jesus, and abiding in Jesus.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Read 2 Corinthians 13:5a. Have you ever wondered if you are truly trusting in Jesus for salvation?
- 2) Have you assumed you are a Christian because you go to church, read your Bible, memorize verses, and behave well?
- 3) Do you understand who Jesus really is, what He has done, and why He did it?
