

Date: June 3, 2018 (33)

Scripture Passage: *I believe that I shall look upon the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living! Wait for the LORD; be strong, and let your heart take courage; wait for the LORD! —Psalm 27:13-14*

Lesson Theme: Waiting in faith is trusting in God's goodness and wisdom.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Is it hard for you to wait to open your Christmas presents? Why?
- 2) Why do I make you wait until the right time to open presents?
- 3) Is it good for you to wait? Why? How is this like waiting for God to keep His promises?

Date: June 10, 2018 (34)

Scripture Passage: *The grass withers, the flower fades, but the word of our God will stand forever. —Isaiah 40:8*

Lesson Theme: God is faithful to all His promises

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What does "faithful to all His promises" mean?
- 2) Why is it so important that we can count on what God has said?
- 3) Think with your child of what it would be like if God did not keep His Word. Imagine a few scenarios, and then reassure your child that God is a promise-keeping God.

Date: June 17, 2018 Review

Scripture Passage: Review

Lesson Theme: Your child will review over the past several week what they have learned.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What is one verse that you remember
- 2) What is one story that you remember?
- 3) How are you different?

Date: June 24, 2018 (35)

Scripture Passage: *Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.—Hebrews 11:1*

Lesson Theme: Faith is believing in God and His promises, even though we can't see the outcome.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Talk to your son or daughter about the ways in which he or she shows faith in you as a parent.
- 2) Why is faith in God a more reliable faith?
- 3) How can you grow in faith in God?
