Date: June 17, 2018 (35)

Scripture Passage: *The LORD is righteous in all his ways and kind in all his works. —Psalm 145:17*

Lesson Theme: Faith is believing that all God's purposes are right.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) In what ways are you tempted to resist God's purposes in your life?
- 2) Why is this a foolish thing for us to do?
- 3) Discuss a time you resisted God's will and what was the outcome.

Date: June 24, 2018 (36)

Scripture Passage: *From of old no one has heard or perceived by the ear, no eye has seen a God besides you, who acts for those who wait for him.—Isaiah 64:4*

Lesson Theme: Faith is trusting God's heart when you cannot see or understand His providential hand.

Family Discussion Questions:
