

Date: June 3, 2018

Scripture Passage: Acts 4:12, Matthew 7:13-14, Joshua 24:14-15, Deuteronomy 30:15-26, 19-20

Lesson Theme: Everyone is either living for the world or living for Jesus. Living for the world is easy but deadly, while living for Jesus is hard but indefinitely worth it.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What are ways we can live for Jesus?
- 2) How can we combat things of this world in our daily lives?
- 3) In what ways is it difficult to follow Jesus?

Date: June 10, 2018

Scripture Passage: 2 Corinthians 11:13-15, Matthew 7:15, Matthew 7:16-20

Lesson Theme: Watch out for false teachers and test those who claim to be from God by the way in which they live their lives.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) How can you draw near to Jesus?
- 2) Why does Jesus warn us about false prophets?
- 3) What is the clearest way to recognize false teachers?

Date: June 17, 2018

Scripture Passage: 1 John 2:3-6, Matthew 7:21-23, Matthew 7:24-27

Lesson Theme: True faith in Jesus Christ creates a growing desire to obey.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What is keeping you from obeying Jesus?
- 2) What is the difference between being religious and having true, saving faith in Jesus?
- 3) Do you have a personal relationship with Jesus?

Date: June 24, 2018

Scripture Passage: Romans 12:1-2, Hebrews 11:13-16, Philippians 3:20

Lesson Theme: The believer will feel out of place in this world. A believer's heart desires and actions show that Jesus is his King and heaven is his ultimate destination.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What does it mean for a Christian to have his citizenship "in heaven"?
- 2) Why are Christians different from the world?
- 3) How can we stand out for Christ?
