

Date: May 6, 2018 (29)

Scripture Passage: *For the LORD will not forsake his people; he will not abandon his heritage;—Psalm 94:14*

Lesson Theme: God will not forsake His people whom He loves with an everlasting love.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Hosea was a good example of faithfulness. In what ways are you faithful?
- 2) Why are people sometimes not faithful to other people?
- 3) Why does God not have any of these problems?

Date: May 13, 2018 (30)

Scripture Passage: “...I am watching over my word to perform it.”—*Jeremiah 1:12b*

Lesson Theme: God is at work, even when we don't see what He is doing.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Why are the works of God often hidden from us?
- 2) How do we know God is at work even when we don't know what He is doing?
- 3) How do we know that we can trust God?

Date: May 20, 2018 (31)

Scripture Passage: *For this light momentary affliction is preparing for us an eternal weight of glory beyond all comparison, 18as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.—2 Corinthians 4:17-18*

Lesson Theme: God is always at work for the good of His children, keeping His promises and fulfilling His plans.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Ask your child to tell you about the difficulties in Joseph's life. What two choices did Joseph have?
- 2) Do we have these two choices?
- 3) How can we help each other fight for a “looking up” response?

Date: May 27, 2018 (32)

Scripture Passage: *The LORD of hosts has sworn: “As I have planned, so shall it be, and as I have purposed, so shall it stand.”—Isaiah 14:24*

Lesson Theme: God always keeps His promises.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What does the life of Joseph show you about God?
- 2) Is it hard to believe these things about God sometimes? Why? When is it hard?
- 3) Are they true, even when it is hard to believe them?
