

**Date:** May 6, 2018 (30)

**Scripture Passage:** *...whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. 7 Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. —2 Corinthians 9:6-7*

**Lesson Theme:** Jesus wants His disciples to give cheerfully and generously.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) What would happen if God's people decided giving wasn't important or necessary?
- 2) Would that show a love for God and His church?
- 3) Would it be loving toward other Christians?

**Date:** May 13, 2018 (31)

**Scripture Passage:** *"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. 35 By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."—John 13:34-35*

**Lesson Theme:** Jesus has given the church specific "one another" commands.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) According to Jesus, what is one reason it is so important for His disciples to love one another?
- 2) How should the love Christians have for one another be different from the ordinary kind of love that even unbelievers have for others?
- 3) If someone came to visit our church a few times, do you think he would see people who love one another with the love Jesus has?

**Date:** May 20, 2018 (32)

**Scripture Passage:** *...but in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect,—1 Peter 3:15*

**Lesson Theme:** Jesus came to seek and save lost sinners.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) Has anyone shared the Gospel of Jesus with you? Just once, or many times?
- 2) How do you respond when the Gospel is shared with you?
- 3) What does Jesus command you to do?

**Date:** May 27, 2018 (33)

**Scripture Passage:** *...“All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. 19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, 20 teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you.”—Matthew 28:18-20a*

**Lesson Theme:** Jesus commands His disciples to spread the message of the Gospel throughout the world.

**Family Discussion Questions:**

- 1) Suppose every single person in our church decided that the only way to obey Jesus' command to go into all the world was to go to a faraway place and share the Gospel. What would happen to our church?
- 2) Who would support all of us and provide the money we need for travel, a new place to live, food, clothes, and everything else?
- 3) Why is it good and wise that Jesus has designed it so that some go, and some stay and send?
