Key themes for discussion:

- Man is a sinful & unable to keep God's commands.
- Sin displeases God and God will punish sin.
- God is rich in mercy & His forgiveness is great.

**Date:** May 27, 2018.

**Scripture Passage:** I Chronicles 28; 29:1-19; II Chronicles 6:12-18

**Lesson Theme:** God chooses Solomon to build the temple (Lesson 50)

**Family Discussion Questions:**
