

Date: September 2, 2018

Scripture Passage: Genesis 2:22-24; Matthew 19:4-5; Hebrews 4:12-13

Lesson Theme: The truth of God's word is absolute, unchanging, knowable, and for everyone. In our culture, truth has been compromised as being relative, changing, uncertain, and for individuals. Everyone who is under God's authority is held accountable by Him.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Which of the characteristics about God's word stuck out to you most? Why?
- 2) What are some factors that influence your "truths"?
- 3) Who should you share these truths with this week in your life?

Date: September 9, 2018

Scripture Passage: Psalm 19:1; Isaiah 40:26; Romans 1:20; John 8:44; Genesis 3:1-5

Lesson Theme: God's truth reigns over everything. Because of Adam and Eve, sin entered and corrupted all of mankind. Sinful people reject the truth of God's word. The rejection of God's truth began with Satan, so it is not a new concept.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) How can you see the rejection of God's truth in your life?
- 2) Why is it important for believers to know that Christians are not immune to rebelling against God?
- 3) What is a scripture to help you fight against the lies of Satan?

Date: September 16, 2018

Scripture Passage: 1 Timothy 6:16; 2 Corinthians 4:4; Romans 1:20; Psalm 10:3-4

Lesson Theme: Satan lies to us telling us that there is no God. God created everything to point back to Him, so all people are without excuse. Because we are naturally prideful with sinful hearts, we naturally reject the truth that God is real.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) How can you use scripture to defend against the lies of atheism?
- 2) What is an example of approaching an atheist friend in love?
- 3) How have you seen God's existence in your own personal experiences?

Date: September 23, 2018

Scripture Passage: 2 Corinthians 11:14-15; 2 Thessalonians 2:9-12; 1 Timothy 2:1-4

Lesson Theme: Satan offers false sight through other religions by disguising himself as an "angel of light." All people have a "God-sized hole" in their life, to know the answers to life's most important questions. Sinful people would rather seek out the lies of other religions than following the truth of God's word, resulting in ultimate condemnation.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) Why do you believe or not believe in Christianity?
- 2) What are some questions that you are struggling through about other religions?



- 3) Who in your life that maybe believes these lies should you partner in prayer with for the Lord to open their eyes to the hope of the Gospel?

Date: September 30, 2018

Scripture Passage: John 1:1;14; Romans 8:7; Hebrews 9:22; Ephesians 2:8-9: John 3:35-36

Lesson Theme: Every false religions ends the same, with God's wrath. Satan uses Islam to blind people from the truth of the Bible. Islam denies the completed work of Jesus as well as God's means of Jesus being the salvation for all sinners.

Family Discussion Questions:

- 1) What scripture can you memorize to help defend against Islam?
- 2) How should believers respond to the claims and practices of Muslims?
- 3) Why does earning God's approval feel easier or better than accepting God's gift?
