**Scripture Passage:** Isaiah 53:12 Therefore I will divide him a portion with the many, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong, because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors.

**Lesson Theme:** God is faithful and good—He provides for all the needs of His people. God is merciful—He is kind to undeserving sinners. God desires to have a special relationship with His people. **Family Discussion Questions:**

- 3) What did God want Israel to learn by this? Read and discuss Lamentations 3:22-23.

- 2) What must Israel do? Does God want them to completely obey His commands, or is most of the time good enough?
- 3) Why is perfect obedience important to God?
