February 5-10, 2018

Monday: Local and Global Impact Partners

- **Pray for our Redeemer Campus** – Justin Pate is the Campus Pastor at Redeemer, a campus Living Hope started Easter, 2017. The campus celebrates God’s work through and in them as they have been a light of hope to many in northern Warren County. Please pray for the congregation as they navigate their new Tuesday night service and several other strategic “reaching out to the community” as they strive to make disciples.
- **Pray Chinese New Year Outreach Celebration** – On Friday, February 16, our Living Hope Chinese Fellowship will host an area wide outreach celebration to our Chinese community. The event takes place in the Student Center from 6-9 p.m. Please pray for this time as there will be many professors, students, and other guests who do not know Jesus as their Savior and Lord. Please pray that they will open their hearts to the gospel as it is shared with them.
- **Pray for our new Karen disciples** – Eleven brothers and sisters from our Galilee Karen Baptist Fellowship have come to faith in Jesus as their Savior and Lord over the past four months. Please pray for these disciples as they grow in the “the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.” *1 Peter 3:18 ESV*

Tuesday: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

- Pray for the counselors at the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling, that they would trust in God and rely on Him to provide them with wisdom to speak to the people that they counsel, instead of relying on their own words and understanding. “Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.” Proverbs 3:5
- Pray that those who come to the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling will be reminded or will come to know of God’s steadfast love towards them and that ultimately their hearts will come to be satisfied and filled with God’s love for them. “Let them thank the Lord for his steadfast love, for his wondrous works to the children of man! For he satisfies the longing soul, and the hungry soul he fills with good things.” Psalm 107:8-9
- Pray for preparations for the Hope Center for Pregnancy, that the foundation will be built “like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when a flood arose, the stream broke against that house and could not shake it, because it had been well built.” Luke 6:48

Wednesday: Missing in Action Members

- Who is someone you did not see at church this Sunday that you usually see?
- Pray this Scripture for them: **Ezekiel 36:25–27** “I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleannesses, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. ²⁶ And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. ²⁷ And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules.”
- Contact them, if you can, and let them know you are praying for them and find out how they are doing.

Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world

This month many people in our city and nation will struggle with Season Affective Disorder.

- Pray for God to give those that are struggling with depression: hope, supportive friends and family, and counseling services.
- Pray for our Biblical Counseling Center counselors, as they seek to care for and disciple those that are struggling with life, during this season
- Pray for medical doctors, school counselors, and others that offer therapy to be strengthened in their calling as they give care to those that are struggling, during this season.

Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.

Focus on the Scripture: **John 20:21** Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, even so I am sending you."

- Ask God to save those in that geographical location and to give them His peace.
- Ask God's Spirit to open their hearts to the truth of the Gospel.
- Ask God to give you the compassion and courage to share the hope of eternal life with them.

Saturday: Pray for Sunday's Worship Gatherings

This Sunday, the sermon will be based on **1 Kings 19:9** and is part of the "God is Greater" sermon series we will start this week. The title of the sermon is "God Is Greater than Our Plans."

- Pray for people you know that are living out their plans and not God's plan for their life.
- Ask God to speak to you about the direction you are going with your life. Invite God to speak to you about the plans He has for you.
- Pray that you will learn to be comforted by God the way Elijah was, when his plans failed.
- Pray that many guests will come and hear the Gospel and be saved.
- Pray that many that have drifted from the Lord will renew their walk with Jesus and get connected in the life of Living Hope.
- Pray that our times of praise honor God and renew our hope in the Gospel.
