

Monday: Local Impact Partners

This week our focus is on the Wellmans in East Asia.

- We have a team of ladies from Living Hope that will be landing on the ground here on Sunday, the 11th. They will be heading out to the village tomorrow to a nearby village where a couple of elder women recently professed belief in Christ. Later in the week they will also get to encourage the other ladies from our company in the nearby areas who also work with unreached people groups. Please pray for those opportunities this week, that the Father would richly bless our time together.
- Please pray for a new contact we made in January in the area we call Peachville. His name is "Stanley" and he has opened up a new village to us as well. Ross is hoping to travel up to see Stanley in the coming weeks and share more with him.
- Please continue to pray for strengthening of existing relationship as well as development of key new relationships. The Father has blessed us with many new relationships every time we visit the villages. However, we need His discernment to know what relationships to invest in the most. More than that, we desperately need His Spirit to pierce hearts and lead to obedience.
- One of our big prayers for this year is that God would call a believer from the East part of our country to come serve with us among the Mountain Bear peoples. While we know they will be crossing cultures themselves to reach the Mountain Bear peoples, they are a nearer culture with less security concerns. Pray that God would clearly call someone and equip them to serve.

Tuesday: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

- Pray that everyone who comes into the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling will come to know more deeply and intimately the love of Christ that surpasses all knowledge and they are filled with the love of Christ. (Ephesians 3:14-21)

Wednesday: Living Hope Family Connections

Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.

Focus on the Scripture: **Matthew 28:19–20** (NIV84) Therefore go and make disciples, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

- Ask God to make you a disciple maker.
- Ask God to bless you with the joy of baptizing new believers.
- Ask God to enable you to obey Jesus and to teach others to obey Jesus.

Saturday: Pray for Sunday’s Worship Gatherings

This Sunday, the sermon will be based on **Genesis 50:22-26**. The Title of the sermon is “God Is at Work through Your World.” Joseph knew that he would not see the end of the plan that God was enacting, but served faithfully until the Lord called him home.
