April 8-13, 2019

Monday: Local and Global Impact Partners

- **Pray for our Fruit** – Please pray for our weekly ministry to the hospitals. Each Thursday, our hospital waiting rooms are visited with Living Hope Missionaries who bring people lunches and living hope. Please pray for each conversation, prayer, and gospel presentation. Pray people will place their hope and trust in Jesus for salvation.
- **Pray for Redeemer Outreach Easter Egg Hunt** – Last year, hundreds of people attended the Redeemer Campus Easter Egg Hunt. This is a great opportunity to point attendees to the hope they can have through the Gospel. Please pray for many to come to faith in Jesus during this huge outreach. It will take place on April 14 at Ephram White Park at 3p.
- **Pray for Hope House Ministries** – Hope House has grown and grown over their last decade of ministry. Please pray for Bryan Lewis and his team as they look to navigate some big changes: family/women’s programmed living and relocation of their offices. A generous donor made 4 acres available to Hope House in the heart of their ministry area on Glen Lily Road.

Tuesday: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

Pray that all the people who enter with their own plans in their hearts will experience the Lord and know that it is the Lord’s plans that prevail. “Many are the plans in a man’s heart, but it is the Lord’s plans that prevails.” **Proverbs 19:21**

Wednesday: Revival in the church, city, and nation.

Focus your prayer around: **Acts 3:19-20** “Repent therefore, and turn back, that your sins may be blotted out, that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord,”

- Pray that the Father who sees and knows all will examine your heart and reveal any thought, attitude, motive, relationship, action, or inaction that does not match his holy character & purpose. Plead for his help to repent and renounce these things so that we may be a faith-family with no barriers, ready for the filling of His Spirit.

Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray that the divisions, violence, agitation, lovelessness, & anger that mark our society would not be seen in His people so that we may, with integrity, point people to the difference that the gospel makes.

- Pray that Christians will be radically loving — in person and on social media.
- Pray that Hoppers in Bowling Green would be kind to all they encounter.

Friday: Pray Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.

Focus your prayer around: **2 Corinthians 6:2** “Behold, now is the favorable time; behold, now is the day of salvation.”

- Pray that every person in our home will be saved.
- Pray for your neighbors who do not know Jesus will be saved.
- Pray for your neighbors who do not attend church every Sunday to accept your invitation to come and worship with you. (Hint: that means you have to invite them.)

Saturday: Pray for Sunday’s Worship Gatherings

This Sunday is Palm Sunday. As we enter into Holy Week, we continue our series: **DIVINE PERSPECTIVE**. We will talk about how **Jesus Is the Saints’ Source of Strength**. Our focus text is Colossians 1:28-29

- Ask God to give you fresh delight in His strength that works in you to live and share His hope.
- Pray that many guests will come and hear the Gospel and be saved.
- Pray that many that have drifted from the Lord will renew their walk with Jesus and get connected in the life of Living Hope.
- Pray that our times of praise honor God and renew our hope in the Gospel.
