June 11-16, 2018

Monday: Local and Global Impact

Our focus this week will be our National Church Planters. This includes the Fisher family in North Dakota (Northern Plains) and the Acrey family planting churches in Cincinnati.

ACREY

- Pray for our summer outreach events...make connections to lost people through these events.
- Prayer for Gary Lamb. He's a new Christian in our church. We met him through a Christmas outreach and he's been very faithful in our church. He was run over by a car while on a motorcycle a few weeks ago. He has a broken femur and cannot work. Their bills don't get paid when he's not at work. Pray for God's continued provision for he and his family and quick healing. It does not appear the other driver has insurance.
- Prayer for the church in general, that God would continue to provide leaders at The Journey Community Church to help disciple people!

FISHER

- Pray for our kid's sports camp we are gearing up for this summer. It is going to be exciting and Spirit filled. We are going to be doing this in an area of town that we have been exploring and pushing more and more into.
- Pray for summer, a time for us to step it up in ministry and also a time that a lot of vulnerable kids are left unattended in our community. Pray for safety for them and pray that we would be the hands and feet of Jesus to them!
- Please pray for my family. God continues to stretch us to do more and be more. We continue to seek out what that would look like and involve. Please pray we would be obedient to His calling in whatever that would be!

Tuesday: Pregnancy Center and Counseling Center

- Pray for the counselors in the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling, that they keep watch on themselves and are not tempted as they counsel others in a spirit of gentleness and bear one another's burdens. Galatians 6:1-2
- Pray for the people who come into the Hope Center for Biblical Counseling, that their eyes will be opened to understanding that, "the thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy," but Christ "came that they may have life and have it abundantly." John 10:10
- Pray for the Hope Center for Pregnancy that, in all we do (construction, strategic plans, training and bible studies), that we remember to seek first the Kingdom of God. Matthew 6:33

Wednesday: Living Hope Family Connections

- Who is someone you did not see at church this Sunday that you usually see?
- Pray this Scripture for them: **Deuteronomy 8:11-14** "Take care lest you forget the LORD your God by not keeping his commandments and his rules and his statutes, which I command you today, ¹² lest, when you have eaten and are full and have built good houses and live in them, ¹³ and when your herds and flocks multiply and your silver and gold is multiplied and all that you have is multiplied, ¹⁴ then your heart be lifted up, and you forget the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery,
- Contact them, if you can, and let them know you are praying for them and find out how they are doing.

Thursday: A need in our city, nation, or world

Pray for our kids at camp. I know this is more of a need in our church, but it's a big deal.

- Pray for those in leadership to serve well.
- Pray the children and leaders stay healthy and safe all week.
- Pray that many of our students will be saved and those that have not been walking as faithful disciples will return to the Lord and follow Jesus.
- Pray that when the students get back, their relationship to Jesus and the church stays strong.
- Pray for the speakers and worship leaders that will be serving at the convention.

Friday: Prayer Walk your home, school, work, or hangout.

Focus on the Scripture: **Revelation 1:4–6** Grace to you and peace from him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven spirits who are before his throne, ⁵ and from Jesus Christ the faithful witness, the firstborn of the dead, and the ruler of kings on earth. To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood ⁶ and made us a kingdom, priests to his God and Father, to him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

- Ask God to give you a supernatural love for those you are praying for and remember that they will soon be judged by holy God.
- Ask God to become disciples of Jesus by repenting and believing in Jesus and following Him.
- Ask God to make you a conduit of His grace and enable you to bring those around you to saving faith in Christ and then to become a part of our church family.

Saturday: Pray for Sunday's Worship Gatherings

We will continue in our summer series: "Rooted!" We will look at what happened when Peter found Jesus praying and how it is that we are called to be a people who are often found in prayer.

- Pray that we will honor the Lord and sing with great joy and delight.
- Pray that we will have ears that can hear the message and respond in faith to God's call for us to be a people of prayer.
- Pray that many that have drifted from the Lord will renew their walk with Jesus and get connected in the life of Living Hope.
- Pray that our time in the Scripture will renew our hope in the authority of God's Word.
