## March 16-21, 2020

### DAILY AWAKENING PRAYER:

Pray that Living Hope would mourn for those who do not know Jesus and His law of love and that the church would be moved to reach out to the community with the gospel of God.

### MONDAY: National Church Plant Partners

#### Fisher's (Fargo, ND):

- Sojourn has had some big changes in the last month. Pray for them while they traverse these changes and faithfully follow Christ calling on them.
- There is a teenager they have been ministering to who was arrested last week and placed in juvenile detention. They are very concerned about him and his future. His mother is not involved and this could place him into the foster care system.
- The Fisher's have a growing faith in their oldest and love watching this flourish in her.
- Their middle kiddo has made a profession of faith and has been hesitant on baptism. At times it confounds them, but they continue to press on.
- Their youngest is learning so much. Pray for the Lord to lay claim on his heart.
- Pray for John and Abby that they would be strong in the midst of trials and show resolve even when it is hard!

#### Acrey's (Liberty, OH):

- Pray that God would continue to use their church outreach and church families to reach more people for Christ!
- Pray that God would be clear what He wants for the Journey Church in a more permanent worship space in 2020!
- Pray that financial giving would continue to grow in order to become more self-sustained in year 3!

Focus your prayer around: **Jeremiah 33:3 (ESV)**: "Call to me and I will answer you, and will tell you great and hidden things that you have not known."

**Pray:** *Father, You have declared in Your Word that if I call to You that You will show me great and mighty things which I do not know. I am calling to You, O God! I am pleading with You to grant revival to the believers of Living Hope. We desperately need it. You have the power to grant it. I am calling on You and am believing You for this. This is Your Word. I am calling to You, Father. Will You be true to Your Word? Are you going to be faithful to Your promise Father? For the sake of Your Word, I plead that You will grant revival to Your people.*

### THURSDAY: A need in our city, nation, or world

Continue to pray for the needs associated with the coronavirus outbreak.

- Pray for those infected with the coronavirus to be healed.
- Pray for those grieving the loss of loved ones to be comforted and to look to Jesus.
- Ask God to give wisdom to world leaders to care for the sick and protect the people of their country.
- Pray for those working on a cure to stay healthy and find a cure.
- Pray for practical and just ways to isolate the virus from the healthy population.

### FRIDAY: Pray Living Hope (LH) will impact our homes, our neighbors, and every generation with the hope of Jesus.

**SATURDAY: Pray for our worship gathering**

This Sunday we continue our series: **See How Homes Are Made Healthy**

**Title: It Happens with Divine Appointments | Text: Acts 16:14, 18, 34**

**Main Thrust:** God is at work in every part of society. Paul and his guys tried to go East. God called them to Europe. Lydia, this girl, and this jailer with his family were there. God had an appointment for them to hear His Gospel. Paul was sent there.

- Challenge people to go and share and to be looking for God to show up.
- Encourage people with the fact that God has the divine appointments for each of us.
- Teach people to look for God in everyday life. He is showing up in special ways. We will miss Him, if we are not willing to look. Sometimes it is overwhelming: girl and jailer. Sometimes, it's in the usual act of normal gatherings like with Lydia by the river.
- Help people see God's provision, even when there was no synagogue. He can't be stopped.

Next Week's Text: **Proverbs 3:1-8**
