## Prayer Garden

### Guidelines

The Garden Committee's goal is to oversee and make sure that the garden at St. Margaret's is well kept and pleasant, year round. We are providing the following guidelines to help our current and future volunteer caretakers with the responsibilities of maintaining one or more specific stations.

- Bring your own garden tools.
- Make sure that all plants and shrubs are trimmed back so that they do not cover any part of the walkway and common areas.
- Weeds should be kept under control either through manual removal or treated with a weed/grass killer.
- To control weeds, it is suggested that you first lay down landscape cloth and then cover the areas with bark mulch where appropriate.
- There is no source of water so keep in mind that anything you plant should be drought tolerant and low maintenance.
- Remove any branches/leaves that you have trimmed or cut down from **station** and **common** areas.
- Remove any trash or litter that may have accumulated on or around the station area.
- Bring trash bags with you for disposal of foliage/trash and place next to the dumpster.
- Report any issues, regarding the common areas; to the garden committee such as, down, broken or low hanging branches, overgrown limbs, etc.
